When are the sessions and how long are they?

The general sessions will take place over two weekends, June 11-12 and 25-26. In between the general sessions will be bonus specialty workshops and breakout sessions on June 16 and 23rd. Review the full agenda for times.

Will they be recorded?

*Yes, we know that you might not be able to make all the sessions, so we will record the live sessions and add them to your course dashboard within 48 hours so that you have access to the recordings on-demand **when you are ready. (The only sessions that will not be recorded are the round-table breakout sessions as these are live and interactive)*

How long can I watch them?

Those who have purchased All Access ticket will have lifetime access to the recordings.

Those who have purchased the 'Lite' ticket will have 30 day access to the recordings.

What if I can't attend any of the live sessions? Is this conference still for me?

Yes! The recordings will be comprehensive on their own. Plus, everyone who signs up for the conference also receives access to our networking app where you can connect with other participants, ask questions, and further discuss session topics

Can I earn Nursing CEU credit? Do you offer CE credit for other disciplines?

What is the ONE Conference Lite? How much is it?
